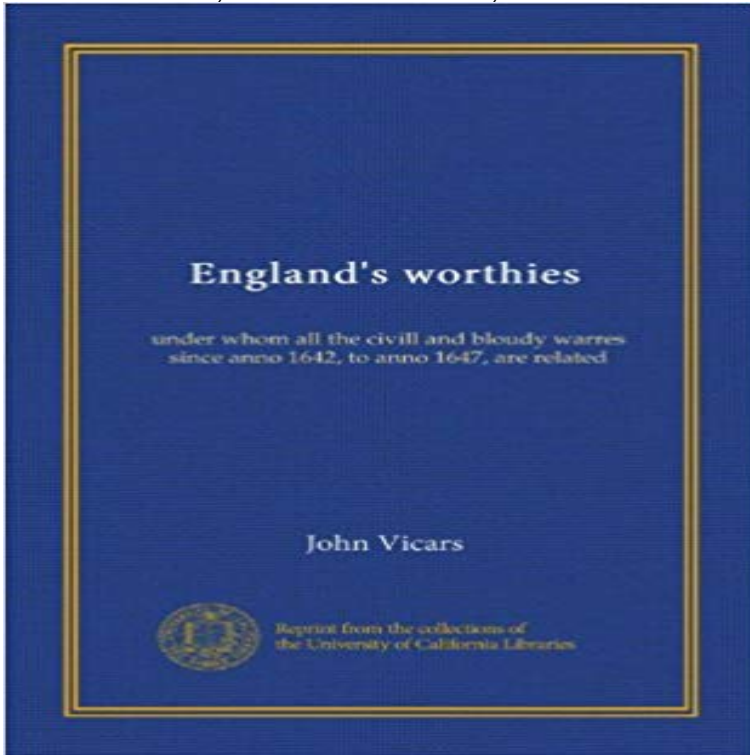


Englands worthies: under whom all the civill and bloody warres since anno 1642, to anno 1647, are related
