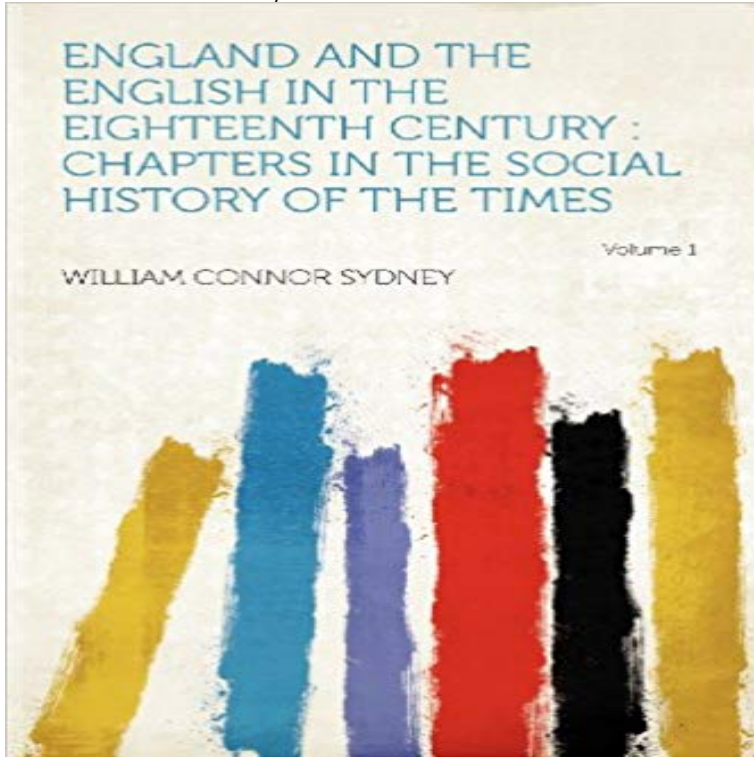


England and the English in the Eighteenth Century: Chapters in the Social History of the Times Volume 1
