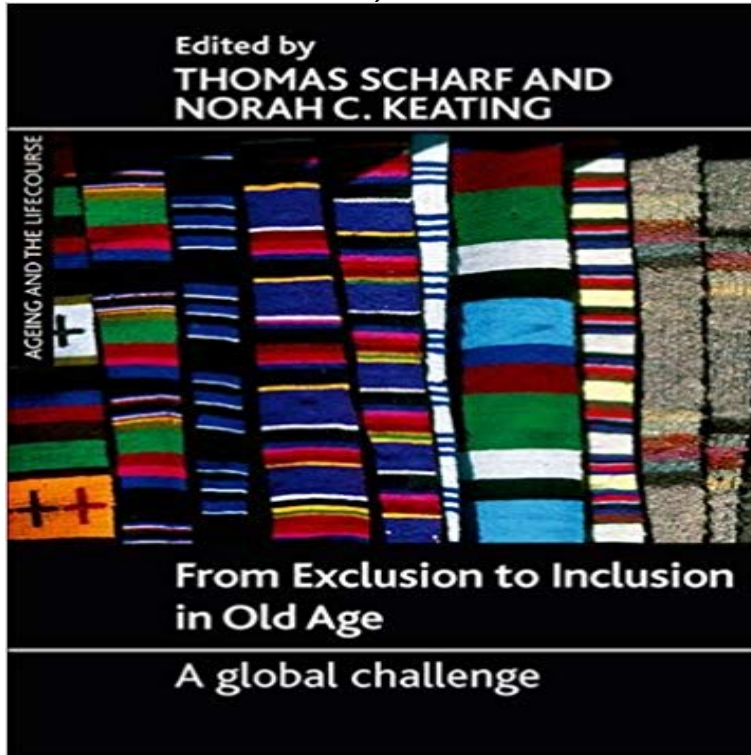


From Exclusion to Inclusion in Old Age: A Global Challenge (Ageing and the Lifecourse)
