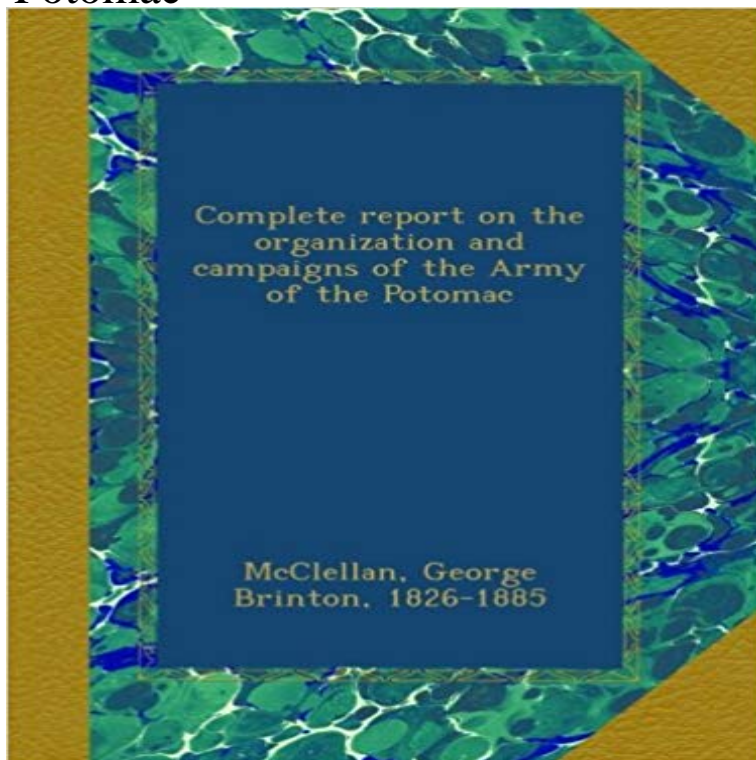


Complete report on the organization and campaigns of the Army of the Potomac
