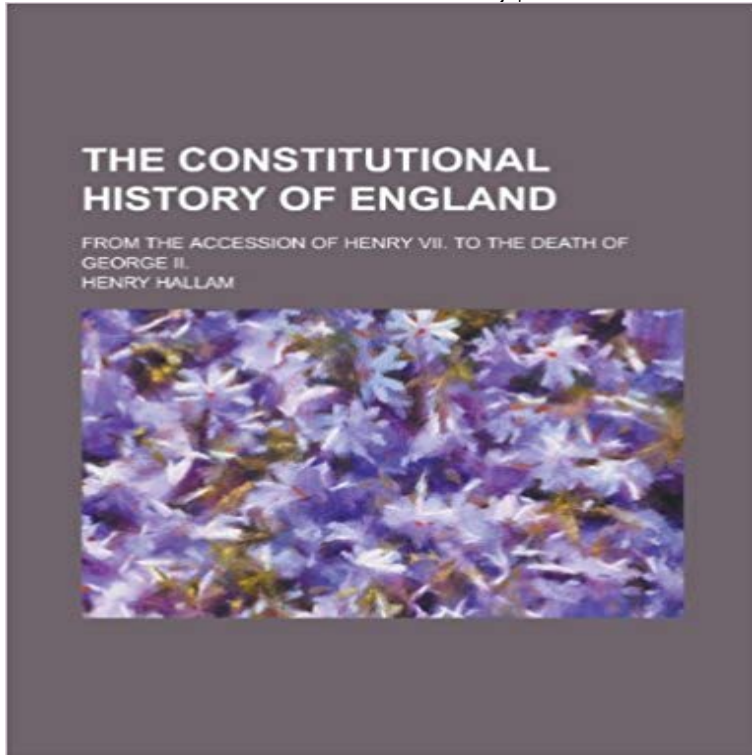

That party was still so weak that the commons came more slowly, and with more difference of judgment, than might be expected, to an absolute renunciation of monarchy. They voted, indeed, that the people are, under God, the original of all just power; and that whatever is enacted by the commons in parliament hath the force of law, although the consent and concurrence of the king or house of peers be not had thereto; terms manifestly not exclusive of the nominal continuance of the two latter. They altered the public style from the kings name to that of the parliament, and gave other indications of their intentions; but the vote for the abolition of monarchy did not pass till the 7th of February, after a debate, according to Whitelock, but without a division. None of that clamorous fanaticism showed itself which, within the memory of many, produced, from a far more numerous assembly, an instantaneous decision against monarchy. Wise men might easily perceive that the regal power was only suspended through the force of circumstances, not abrogated by any real change in public opinion. The house of lords, still less able than the crown to withstand the inroads of democracy, fell by a vote of two thirds of the commons at the same time.
