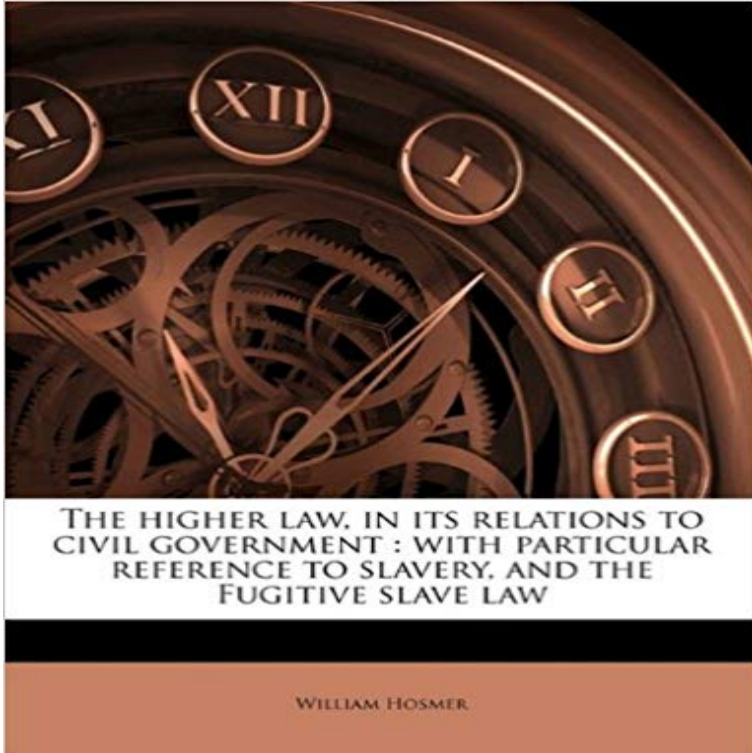


The higher law, in its relations to civil government: with particular reference to slavery, and the Fugitive slave law
