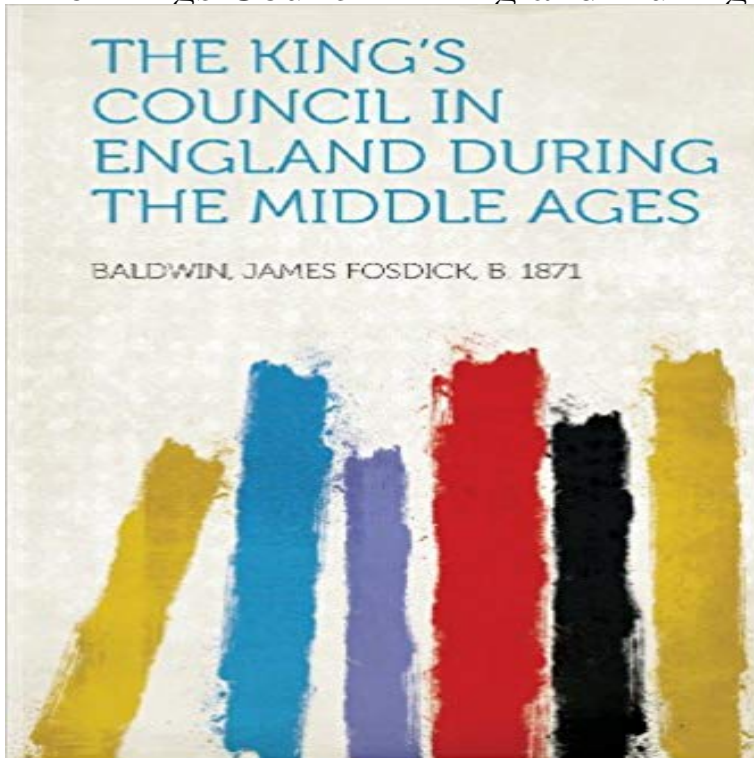


The Kings Council in England During the Middle Ages
