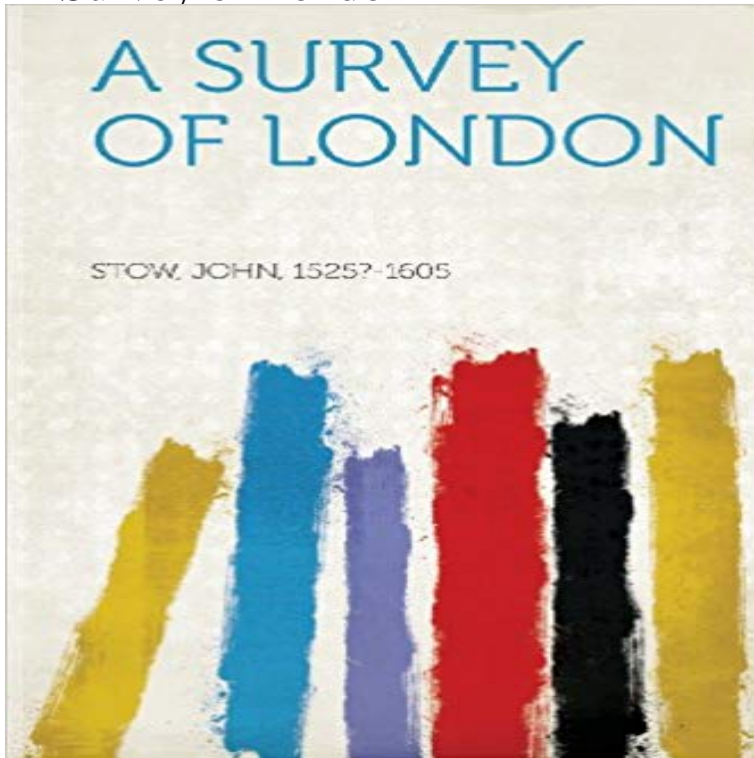


A Survey of London
