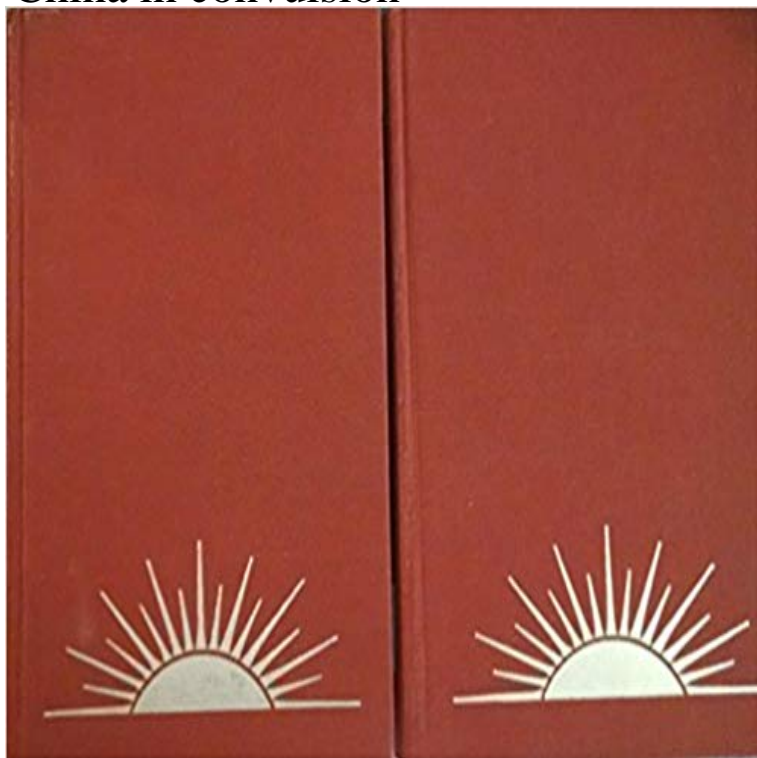


China in convulsion
